

**International Competition for Air Gun, Air Pistol and Running Target
2010-01-03 - 06 in Sweden.**

Swedish Shooting Sport Federation invites all shooters and leaders to Sävsjö and Swedish Cup 2010.

Location :

Sävsjö Shooting Center, Sävsjö, in the southern part of Sweden

Program:

January 3 Arrival. Training and equipment control 1400-1900.

January 4 First day of competition

January 5 Second day of competition

January 6 Third day of competition

Category:

Air Gun / Air Pistol: Male, male junior 60 shots, female, female junior 40 shots.

Running target: Seniors Open class, junior open class. 30+30 shots.

News: Veterans Air gun, born in 1965 or earlier. Open class 40 shots.

Veterans Air pistol, born in 1960 or earlier. Open class 40 shots.

Swedish cup is open to disabled shooters in the class SH 1.

Finals for the rifle o pistol start each day after the last pistol relay.

Medal Match for Running target after the last relay.

No final of the veteran classes of rifle and pistol.

Entry forms:

You find the entry form on the Swedish cups official website. We prefer that you register via the Web. Application deadline is 1 December 2009.

To minimize our workload we ask all Swedish shooters not to register individual entry forms, but, instead, to use one entry form per club.

Entry fees:

600 SEK per shooter for all 3 competition days.

Veterans 500 SEK for all 3 competitions days.

Entry fees must be paid at the same time as entry form is completed for the competition.

Information about payment methods is described under "How to Pay" on the Swedish cup official website .

To minimize our workload we ask all Swedish shooters not to pay their fees individually, but, instead, that all the entry fees from one club are paid at the same time.

Awards:

Medals for the 3 best shooters in each category every day.

2000 SEK at the best shooter in each category after 3 days competition.

Accommodation:

See Accommodation on Swedish cup official website.

Airport:

The nearest airport is Vaxjo, 80 km, and Jönköping, 70 km.

Good alternatives: Kastrup Airport / DEN and then train to Sävsjö.

Transportation:

Airport - Hotel, return tickets 100 SEK/person

Hotel - Shooting Range 300 SEK during all competition days.

All transportations are booked through the transportation order form.
