Rules for the price competition best shooter at Swedish Cup 2009

“AIR RIFLE”

Competition score before final counts as:

World record	= 20 points
1 p less than World record	= 14 p
2 p less than World record	= 13 p
3 p less than World record	= 12 p
And so on... down to 0 point.	

“AIR PISTOL”

Competition score before final counts as:

World record	= 20 points
1 p less than World record	= 18 p
2 p less than World record	= 17 p
3 p less than World record	= 16 p
And so on... down to 0 point.	

All three competition days counts. The shooter with highest score after three rounds wins. If the shooters have the same points, the shooter with highest individual final score wins. If it's still a tie, the next best individual final score wins, and finally if it's still a tie, the third best individual final score wins.
